


1.4: Institution obtains feedback on the syllabus and its transaction at the institution from the following stakeholders




Whether the curriculum and syllabus are well organized and easy to follow 16 responses




Availability of prescribed textbooks and other resources that you need to cover the syllabus 16 responses



Learning objectives are clearly defined and are able to achieve by students 16 responses




Curriculum includes the current and the future socio-economic needs 16 responses




Curriculum having good academic flexibility
