Principal Dr. K.K. Deo, Navjeevan Law college - Member Secretary of College Development Committee gave warm welcome to all the present dignitaries and members for attending the first official meeting of College Development Committee of Navjeevan Law college.

Principal Dr. K.K. Deo introduced the chairperson Mr. Subhash Deshmukh - Managing Trustee NES with all the members. He then explained the composition, object and working of College Development Committee constituted under Maharashtra Public University Act - 2016.

Mr. Subhash Deshmukh, Dr. Dhanaji Jadhav and Mr. Mukteshwar Munshettiwar expressed their views regarding good and productive working of college development committee. Dr. Jadhav suggested to form various sub-committees for the smooth functioning of college day-to-day activities including curricular and extra-curricular activities.

Mr. Vijay Kale, Secretary NES & Member of Committee stressed the need to have more participation of students in the college affairs.

The main issue before the members was the admission process introduced for 3 years and 5 years law course by the Government of Maharashtra.

Principal Dr. K.K. Deo told the members that because of lack of knowledge and propaganda about Law CET, lots of seats were remained vacant of majority of law colleges in Maharashtra in the last Academic year 2016-17. Moreover

the centralised admission process concluded in the month of October and thus hampered the complete teaching & examination schedule. He thus hope that at least this year the admission process will commensurate & concluded according to the schedule fixed by CET cell, Govt. of Maharashtra. Chairperson Mr. Subhash Deshmukh suggested that before starting of actual admission process special meeting should be conveyed to give full information to teaching & non-teaching staff about the admission process. It was also suggested and approved by all the committee members that in the month of March and April law college will take steps by arranging lectures & seminar publicly to aware the public at large about the law admission CET.

Members then visited to Law college library at the request of Librarian Mrs. Mangal Patil. It was decided and approved by all the members that for the Academic year 2017-18, one lac rupees budget should be fixed for updating the law library books and equipments. Members expressed satisfaction for having adequate number of books available in the library. Mrs. Patil informed the members and showed the demonstration of Internet facility availability of the computer for the students.

Mr. Deshmukh, Mr. Kale & Dr. Jadhav asked the faculty members to motivate the students for having more & more access with the internet particularly the judgements of High court & Supreme Courts of India. Dr. Dhanaji Jadhav suggested some national & International journals for subscription to update the library.

The meeting ends with Snaks and High Tea. The members decided to meet on Saturday 11th of November 2017 for the next meeting.

In presence of Mr. Subhash Deshmukh - managing trustee, Navjeevan Education society, Principal and Member Secretary of College Development Committee Dr. K. K. Deo welcomed all the members of College Development Committee. He then circulated the agenda of the 4th meeting of college Development Committee. The following things are discussed amongst the members,

- 1) As per the direction given in the previous meeting, Prin. Dr. K. K. Deo Sir presented yearly planner (action plan-report) for the Academic year 2018-2019 before all the college development committee members. In this report, he gave the information starting from Admission, Teaching Schedule, Circular and Extra curricular activities, Seminar, workshop, Examination, result etc. He informed the members that from this Academic year LLB 1st year and B.A LLB 1st year examinations will be conducted at college level. The paper assessment is also done in the college and the result will also be declared by the college. This is provided in the University circular. The copy of circular is supplied to every member. Members discussed the circular and gave suggestions for the difficulties which may arise in future by the college. Principal Dr. K. K. Deo asked the management members for a separate stall having good sitting arrangement for examiners and other infrastructural facilities. Such as Cupboard, Computer, Printer, Stationary etc.

It is decided that the CAP room will be Skill development - room (Hall), where all arrangements will be made to have security of answer papers and examination of answer sheets of the examinee.

② Principal Dr. K.K. Deo informed the members about the Conditional Affiliation letter given by the University for the Academic year 2018-19. The copy of letter is shown to each of the members. While granting affiliation to the college, the University put the condition regarding the appointments of full-time teachers (Lecturers) for Non-law Subjects. This Subjects includes English, Sociology, Political science and Economics. According to University norms these lecturers should be qualified i.e. having their MA Degree in the relevant Subject along with necessary Criteria of NET/SET. Dr. Ravasahab Shinde asked the principal to proceed further for appointing the lecturers. Mr. Subhash Deshmukh, Managing Trustee also consented for making such appointments to fulfill the norms of J.P. Pune University. He instructed Principal Dr. Deo Sir and Head Clerk Mr. A.P. Deshmukh to give advertisement in the News Paper for filling the required posts.

③ The issue of Admissions to five years Law Course B.A.L.L.B is again raised by Mr. Subhash Deshmukh, Managing Trustee, Navjeevan Ed. Society, Nashik. Principal Dr. K.K. Deo informed him that the admission process is done through CET conducted by Govt. of Maharashtra. The awareness is still lacking amongst the Parents to send their Pupil for doing Law Course. Dr. Dhanaji Jadhav told that the course is very useful for the XII<sup>th</sup> Passed out Students rather than taking the admission after graduation. Principal Dr. K.K. Deo and Head Clerk Mr. Anil Deshmukh informed the members that all assistance is given to the students who approached the college regarding the information of CET, syllabus of CET and making application.



In Presence of Mr. Subhash Deshmukh Managing Trustee, Navjeevan Education Society, Nashik, Member Secretary and Principal of Navjeevan Law College, welcomed all the members of College Development Committee. The Agenda of the Meeting is Circulated amongst all the members of the College Development Committee. The following things are discussed by the members:

(1) Principal Dr. K. K. Deo informed the members about the letter received from the Bar Council of India regarding the extension of approval of affiliation to Navjeevan Law College for the academic year 2018-19. The copy of interim consent letter is provided to each of the member to go through the contents in detail. Principal Dr. K. K. Deo read out the important paragraphs and conditions put up by the Bar Council while granting the permission of Affiliation to the law college for the academic year 2018-19. The main conditions stipulated and mandatorily to be fulfilled by the law college are;

- (i) The college should purchase the required number of computers for the computer lab;
- (ii) The college should modify the moot court room as per the BCI norms within three months;
- (iii) The college should maintain a register showing the activities conducted by the legal Aid Center.
- (iv) The college should provide a provision for separate computer lab.

(vi) The college should invest Rs. 2 lakhs per year for library, online facilities and I.T. facilities.

(vii) Teacher-student ratio should be maintained as per Bar Council of India Education rules.

(viii) Center of Legal Education shall equip itself to provide appropriate facilities in terms of the Physical infrastructure, Academic infrastructure and any other facilities required for the effective participation of disabled students, teachers and staff in their respective activities. For e.g. (a) Ramps in public buildings and (b) Braille symbols and auditory signals in elevators or lifts.

It is very specifically provided that, all the conditions should be strictly complied with and the Bar Council will verify the fulfillment of conditions during the next inspection.

Dr. Dhanaji Jadhav and Dr. Raasahob Shinde expressed their view that these conditions are not letters but should be taken positively for the development of the college.

Dr. K.K. Desai, Principal NLC stressed the need of fulfillment of all these mandatory things. He urged the management members to support and take every steps as early as possible for fulfillment of these specific conditions imposed by the inspection team and approved by the Legal Education Committee of Bar Council of India.

Mr. Subhash Deshmukh, Managing Trustee, NES, instructed Mr. Vijay Kale, Secretary, Navjeevan Education Society, to sit and chalked out the plan, along with the Principal Dr. Desai and all the teaching and non-teaching staff for fulfilling the conditions specified by Bar Council of India report within a span of three months. He assured the committee members that financial problem would never come and all support will be provided.

for this urgent and important matter, in the interest of Law College.

Regarding non-payment of Bar Council of India inspection fees, Mr. Subhash Deshmukh, Managing trustee, HES asked principal Dr. Deo Sir to make correspondence with Bar Council asking more clarification.

Principal Dr. Deo Sir expressed his sincere thanks for giving due weightage to the demand of Law College and wish that all the conditions specified in the report will be fulfilled well within specified time limit.

- ② Principal Dr. Deo Sir instructed all the members that as suggested by Hon. Bade Sir, daily prayer is performed by all teaching and non-teaching staff.
- ③ College Examination officer, Asst. Professor Samir Chavan and Asst. Professor Mrs. Pradhyumna Sawarkar gave full information of Examination Patterns of M.B and B.A.L.L.B examination to all the members. 
④ The various activities done by the college during the pandemic was thoroughly discussed and admired by all the members.


Members expressed their satisfaction towards the Admission process and the activities conducted during the last three months.
