conduct the future programmes. All the feedback reports are placed before the College Development Committee for discussion, consideration and seek expert guidance.






#### Q2. Relevance of the syllabus as expected by the job market


## Q2. Relevance of the syllabus as expected by the job market 41 responses


#### Q4. Content of the syllabus in terms of practical know how






#### Q6. Adequacy of Text books/Reference books mentioned for the courses






#### Q8. Satisfaction on the current system of Continuous Evaluation




#### Q9. Transparency of the mechanism of Continuous Evaluation


Q9. Transparency of the mechanism of Continuous Evaluation 42 responses








Q3. Learning objectives are clearly defined and are able to achieve by students.






#### Q5. Curriculum having good academic flexibility.








Q2. Effectiveness of curriculum in attaining communication skills and social responsibility.


Q2. Effectiveness of curriculum in attaining communication skills and social responsibility. 5 responses










# .Q3. Effectiveness of curriculum to meet your present professional standards.


Q3. Effectiveness of curriculum to meet your present professional standards. 25 responses


