
# Q1.Standard of syllabus offered by the courses Total Responses: 42






# Q5.Balance of the syllabus with respect to theory and practical Total Responses 42



## Q8. The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good. Total Responses 42








Q1. Whether the curriculum and syllabus are well organized and easy to follow?


Q2. Availability of prescribed text books and other resources that you need to cover the syllabus.




