
Feedback Report


Q1.Standard of syllabus offered by the courses Total Responses: 48

Q2. Relevance of the syllabus as expected by the job market Total Responses: 48











Q7.Scope of extra learning





Q9. Transparency of the mechanism of Continuous Evaluation



Q10.Satisfaction on the current system of End Semester Examination Responses 48




Q1. Whether the curriculum and syllabus are well organized and easy to follow?


Q2. Availability of prescribed text books and other resources that you need to cover the syllabus.


3. Learning objectives are clearly defined and are able to achieve by students.






