



MEMORUNDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1. Parties

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by and

BETWEEN

DR. PANJABRAO DESHMUKH COLLEGE OF LAW, AMRAVATI (Maharashtra), Affiliated to Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati. (Hereinafter referred to as DR.PDCL)

AND

Navjeevan Law College, (NLC) Shivshakti Chowk, 4th Scheme, CIDCO, Nashik – 422 008. (Hereinafter referred to as NLC)

2. Objectives:

The objective of this MoU is to establish collaborative linkages between the Parties, in the area of learning events (e.g. workshops, seminars, symposia, forums and academic conferences hereinafter the "Events") and publication for exchange of information and for legal issues, educational purposes.

This MoU is a general, non-binding statement of mutual intentions of the parties. Any binding commitment or legal obligation with respect to the implementation of this MoU will require the execution of a separate and formal agreement between the parties.

3. Purpose and Scope:

- (iii) Teaching: Adjunct Faculty providing practical insights into the Legal Practice through classes covering specialized subjects relating to Intellectual Property and Information Technology. Guide LLB and PhD students with their Dissertations or projects that will be done in as per suitability of circumstances.
- (iv) Research: Research for prospective projects including filing of Patents, GIs, Trademarks and Copyrights and new areas as per recommendation of UGC.
- (v) Conferences / Seminars/ Exhibitions / Symposia/ Workshops/ Training Programs: as mentioned above.
- (vi) Provide outreach for speakers, coaches mentors and webinars to each other's developmental initiatives
- (vii) Any other relevant activity which agreed by both the parties.

4. MoU Term:

This MoU is for a period of 5 years. It can be extended further by mutual consultation and agreement. This MoU shall be effective and will come into force from the day the two authorized signatories of both the parties formally sign the MoU document. The authorized signatories and / or the Coordinators of DR PDCL and will implement this MoU and all endeavors that derive from it. Both the parties develop and carry out joint plans for the implementation of the objectives of the MoU. MoU by having regular communications implement the programme and submit yearly 'Status reports'.

Additional activities proposed within the framework of the general terms of this MoU will be formally incorporated as an addendum to this MoU, provided the addendum is agreed to and signed by both parties. Both DR. PDCL and NLC, shall inform in writing the respective communities of this MoU to draw benefits from it and to contribute towards its implementation in spirit and substance.

10. Termination of memorandum:

This MoU will come into effect upon the date of its signature by both Parties hereto. This MoU may be terminated by either of the Parties upon written notice to the other Party and will terminate 60 days after receipt of such notice.

11. Review and Amendment:

The terms and conditions of this MoU may be changed only by mutually agreed and accepted written amendments signed by both signatories, which will be annexed to this MoU, of which they will form an integral part. Such amendments ad revision shall be effective from the date of signing the new agreement

12. Channel of Communication and Notice:

Any notice to be given to either Party with respect to this MoU will be considered as effectively given, if delivered or sent by letter through post or by email or by fax. Any such notice will become effective on the day of its receipt by the Party to which it is addressed. The address of either Party may be changed by appropriate notice to the other Party.

13. Settlement of Dispute:

Any dispute arising out of this MoU will be settled by mutual negotiations between the two Parties. In witness whereof each of the parties has caused this MoU to be executed in two originals, one has been retained with the DR. PANJABRAO DESHMUKH COLLEGE OF LAW, AMRAVATI and the other with NAVJEEVAN LAW COLLEGE, NASHIK (NLC).


