



Q2. Relevance of the syllabus as expected by the job market Total Responses: 42



Q3. Adequacy of content in terms of syllabi of competitive examinations




Q4.Content of the syllabus in terms of practical know how

Q5.Balance of the syllabus with respect to theory and practical





Q7.Scope of extra learning






