The Committee examined the complaints register and discussed the general conduct and discipline of students. It was noted that **no complaint or incident relating to ragging had been received or reported** during the period under review.

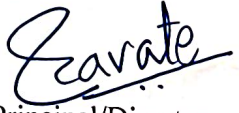
