Proceedings of the Meeting

The members observed that maintaining continuous awareness and vigilance is important for preventing ragging and ensuring a secure academic atmosphere.

The Committee discussed the need to remind students about the prohibition of ragging and the appropriate mechanism for reporting any incident. The members also emphasized mutual respect, discipline, and responsible behavior among students.

Resolutions

1. The College shall continue to maintain a strict zero-tolerance policy towards ragging.
2. Regular awareness and sensitization of students shall be undertaken.
3. The Committee shall continue monitoring the campus for prevention of ragging.
4. Students shall be encouraged to report any incident or concern immediately.
5. Appropriate action shall be taken in accordance with applicable anti-ragging rules if any complaint is received.
